## CLOSED SESSION

**MOTION:** Director Clewell moved the Board hold a closed session as provided in section 21.5(1)(e) of the open meetings law to conduct a hearing to determine whether to suspend, expel or exclude a student, unless an open session is requested by the student, or a parent or guardian of the student if the student is a minor. Director Roberson seconded the motion.

**STUDENT CASE #0501  
SUSPENSION SUFFICIENT**

**MOTION:** Director Tupper stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #-0501, the Board adopts the amended findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council. The Board concludes that the suspension for Student Case #0501 currently imposed and served to date is sufficient for the conduct described. Director Roberson seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows. Ayes: Tupper, Roberson, DeFauw, Clewell, Johanson, and Zamora. Motion carried unanimously.

**EXPULSION STUDENT CASE #0502**

Director Clewell read that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0502, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school.

**MOTION:** Director Clewell moved that after the Board consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0502:

1. That Student Case #0502 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2005-2006 school year;
2. That Student Case #0502 will receive alternative services at Harrison Street during the time of the expulsion;
3. That Student Case #0502 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion, other than the site of the alternative programming; and
4. That Student Case #0502 will return to the Administrative Advisory Council for appropriate placement before the beginning of the 2006-2007 school year.

Director Tupper seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows. Ayes: Clewell, Tupper, Roberson, Johanson, DeFauw, and Zamora. Motion carried unanimously.
