Director Portes stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0234, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Portes moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0234:

1. That Student Case #0234 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2002-2003 school year;
2. That Student Case #0234 will receive alternative services at the Harrison Street Program during the time of the expulsion;
3. That Student Case #0234 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event (including athletic events) where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion, other than the site of the alternative programming;
4. That the Administrative Advisory Council will meet prior to the beginning of the 2003-2004 school year to determine appropriate placement for Student Case #0234.

Director Roberson seconded the motion.

EXPULSION OF STUDENT CASE #0235

Director Guard stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0235, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:

MOTION: Director Guard moved that after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0235:

1. That Student Case #0235 will be expelled from the Davenport Community School District for the remainder of the 2002-2003 school year;
2. That Student Case #0235 will receive services at the Harrison Street Program during the time of the expulsion;
3. That Student Case #0235 will not be allowed on any Davenport Community School District property or be in attendance at any school event where a Davenport team is participating during the time of the expulsion, other than the site of the alternative programming; and
4. That prior to the beginning of the 2003-2004 school year, the Administrative Advisory Council will meet to determine appropriate placement for Student Case #0235.

Director Portes seconded the motion.

The vote on the motion was called and recorded as follows: Ayes: Guard, Portes, Hanson, Hunter, Roberson, and Low. Motion carried unanimously.

Director Hanson stated after the Board's consideration of the evidence presented in the matter of the recommendation to expel Student Case #0236, the Board adopts the findings of fact set out in the Administrative Advisory Council, and the Board concludes the student violated the regulations and rules established by the Board and the continued presence of the pupil is detrimental to the best interest of the school:
